

SELECTION CRITERIA TO REPRESENT INDIA AT MAJOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023

1.	Asian Junior Team, Chennai	Top 4 players on the basis of results at selection trials.
2.	Asian Junior Individual, China	Top 2 ranked (govt. cost) + next 2 ranked players (own cost) in the Boys & Girls u13 u15, u17 & u19 categories on the basis of results at selection trials
3.	WSF World Junior Championship, Australia	Top 6 players on the basis of results at selection trials.
4.	British Junior Open	Players selected as per SRFI ranking.

Criteria to be invited for selection trials for Invitation Asian / World Junior Championships

1. Players ranked top 6 in SRFI ranking in their respective age category.
2. Players ranked top 2 in SRFI ranking in the lower age category (if applicable).
3. SRFI reserves the right to call for trials such other players who, in their opinion, are promising enough to represent India at any championship.

The selection committee comprising the SRFI Patron, President, Vice President, Secretary General and an eminent ex – sportsperson shall select the individuals/teams for selection trials (if required) and/or represent the country.

Other factors that may be considered for selection to represent India:

- a) Performance in physical fitness tests at the selection trials/camps if conducted.
- b) Attitude and discipline during training and competition.
- c) Preference for eligible players for the next junior team championship.
- d) Only Indian citizens with Indian passports are eligible to represent India.
