SQUASH RACKETS FEDERATION OF INDIA

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. General

Coaching camps and selection trials may be conducted by SRFI. Selection trials will be used as a guide for selecting players to participate in international tournaments. Participation in the selection trials and coaching camp is compulsory for eventual selection to represent India. However, exemptions from attending coaching camps and or selections trials may be given at SRFI's discretion.

2. To Represent India In International Senior Championships

In a team of 4 players, a maximum of 3 players may be selected based on their PSA/WSA rankings at least 45 days prior to the closing date of entries for the tournament. For any event where less than 4 players are required, selection may be based on PSA/WSA rankings at least 45 days prior to the closing date. A selection trial may be held if required. Invitation to selection trials will be at SRFI's discretion.

3. To Represent India In International Junior Championships

a) Asian Junior Individual Championships

Players may be selected to represent India based on their March SRFI junior rankings for the event which is normally held in June/July. A selection trial may be held if required, and the top 4 players in their category (based on March rankings) will be invited. Other players may be invited at the discretion of the SRFI. In the event a current national champion shifts into a higher age category, he/she may be invited for selections trials even if not in the top 4 in the March rankings. Do note that the number of invitees may vary for different categories.

b) Asian Junior Team Championship / World Junior Individual & Team Championship

Players may be selected to represent India based on their junior rankings / performances in national / international competitions during the preceding 12 months.

The selection trials for the Asian Junior Individual if held may also be considered for selecting players to represent India for the Asian Junior Team / World Junior Individual & Team event(s). A second selection trial may be held if required where other players may be invited at the discretion of the SRFI.

c) British Junior Open

As there is a restriction of 5 players per age category, players will be selected to participate in this event based on their November SRFI junior ranking.

4. Selection Committee

The selection committee shall select the individuals / teams for selection trials (if required) and/or represent the country. The committee shall consist of the President / Secretary General of the federation, consultant coach, national coach and an eminent ex – sportsperson.

Other factors that may be considered for selection to represent India:

- Performance in physical fitness tests at the selection trials / camps, if conducted.
- Attitude and discipline during training and competition.
- Preference for players who are eligible for the next junior team championship.
- Only Indian citizens with Indian passports are eligible to represent India.
