

SELECTION CRITERIA TO REPRESENT INDIA AT GOVT. COST FOR 2018-2019 EVENTS

Junior Championships

1.	02–04 Mar German Junior Open, Hamburg, Germany	Top 2 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u15 & u17 categories
2.	May Malaysian Junior Open, Penang	Top 2 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u11, u13 & u15 categories
3.	6 – 9 Jul Cologne Junior Cup Cologne, Germany	Top 2 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u13 & u15 categories
4.	12–15 Jul Dutch Junior Open, Amsterdam, Netherlands	Top 2 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u13 & u15 categories
5.	18–23 Jul WSF Women’s World Junior Individual (u19), Chennai	Top 6 players on the basis of performance in events / camps / selection trials (if held)
6.	18–29 Jul WSF Men’s World Junior Individual & Team Championship (u19), Chennai	Top 6 players on the basis of performance in events / camps / selection trials (if held)
7.	Aug Hong Kong Junior Open	Top 2 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u11, u13 & u15 categories
8.	26 – 29 Sep 25th Asian Junior Individual, India	Top 6 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u13 u15, u17 & u19 will be eligible to participate in the championship
9.	3 – 7 Jan British Junior Open 2019, Birmingham	Top 2 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u11, u13 u15, u17 & u19 categories
10.	Feb French Junior Open, 2019 Lille, France	Top 2 ranked players in the Boys & Girls u15 & u17 categories

Senior Championships

1.	05 – 15 Apr Commonwealth Games, Australia	On the basis of PSA ranking
2.	18 Aug – 02 Sep Asian Games, Indonesia	Top 4 players on the basis of PSA ranking / selection trials (if held)
3.	10 -16 Sep Women’s World Team, China	Top 4 players on the basis of PSA ranking / selection trials (if held)

Note

1. SRFI rankings will be considered as on the closing date of entries. Players would be required to have played at least 2 championships in their selected category in the past 12 months.
2. For the junior individual events, if a player ranked top 2 is not eligible or does not wish to participate in the event, the next highest ranked player may be selected (not automatically) at the discretion of the SRFI. Additional categories / players may be added at the discretion of the SRFI.
3. The SRFI will try to obtain financial assistance from the Govt. of India for the above championships. In the event we receive the approval but do not receive the advance money prior to the travel date, players would be reimbursed by the government as per the govt. norms on the production of original bills. In the event we do not receive the approval from the govt., players would have to pay all expenses.
4. Amendments to the above may be made at the discretion of the SRFI.
