

SELECTION CRITERIA TO REPRESENT INDIA AT MAJOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019-20

Junior Championships

1.	16-20 Jan; Asian Junior Team Championship, Thailand	Top 4 players in the Boys & Girls on the basis of results at selection trials
2.	26-30 Jun; 26th Asian Junior Individual, Macau	Top 2 ranked (govt. cost) + next 2 ranked players (own cost) in the Boys & Girls u13 u15, u17 & u19 categories on the basis of results at selection trials
3.	5-8 Jul; European Junior Open, Cologne, Germany	Top 2 ranked (govt. cost) in the Boys & Girls u13 & u15 on the basis of results at selection trials
4.	11-14 Jul; Dutch Junior Open, Amsterdam, Netherlands	
5.	30 July-4 Aug; WSF Men's World Junior Individual (u19), Malaysia	Top 4 players on the basis of results at selection trials
6.	5-9 Aug WSF Women's World Junior Individual & Team Championship (u19), Malaysia	Top 4 players on the basis of results at selection trials
7.	2-6 Jan; British Junior Open 2020, Birmingham	Players finishing top 4 at the Asian Junior Individual Championship

Senior Championships

1.	1-5 May; Asian Senior Individual Championships, Malaysia	Top 4 players on the basis of results at selection trials
2.	15-21 Dec; Men's World Team Championship, USA	Top 4 players on the basis of results at selection trials

Note

1. Following the norms laid down by GOI/IOA, participation in major events representing India, entries will be restricted to players ranked top 4. Therefore, for the major individual events, criteria will be as given above.
2. If SRFI rankings are to be considered, it will be as on the closing date of entries. Players would be required to have played at least 2 championships in their selected category in the past 12 months.
3. For the junior individual events, if a player ranked top 2 is not eligible or does not wish to participate in the event, the next highest ranked player will not be selected automatically. Additional categories / players at govt. costs or at players own cost may be added at the discretion of the SRFI.
4. The SRFI will try to obtain financial assistance from the Govt. of India for the above championships. In the event we receive the approval but do not receive the advance money prior to the travel date, players would be reimbursed by the government as per the govt. norms on the production of original bills. In the event we do not receive the approval from the govt., players would have to pay all expenses.
5. Amendments to the above may be made at the discretion of the SRFI.
